BLOCKADES IMPACTING CANADIAN RAIL NETWORK

February 26, 2020

Dear Valued Customer,

This is an update to previous advisories regarding the blockades impacting the Canadian Rail Network (CN). The blockades are caused by Canada's First Nations tribe demonstrations (protests unrelated to CN).

After two-weeks of protests, the blockade at Tyendinaga, ON (Eastern Canada) is being cleared and CN is working to resume operations. CN continues its recovery plan in western Canada.

According to the JOC*, "...the Port of Montreal said over the weekend that about 15 percent of the containers at the port were 'immobilized' by the blockades. But the vast majority of goods were unaffected... On Friday, CMA CGM told customers that... Montreal Gateway Terminals Partnership... had enacted a force majeure, asking for all inland cargo to be 'evacuated immediately'."
