## Dear Valued Customer,

As the COVID 19 virus spreads globally, APL Logistics is issuing regional advisories to provide a clearer picture of possible impacts and preparations being made.

The Port of Baltimore issued a notice last week that the Seagirt Marine Terminal will be closed March 5th and March 17th. The closure is in response to a decline in international cargo volumes, triggered by the COVID 19 viral outbreak. For more details, please see <u>this article</u> from JOC.com.
