As reported from media outlets, Hurricane Laura made landfall in the Gulf Coast region of the U.S. on Wednesday night. In the aftermath of Hurricane Laura, many ports across the Texas-Louisiana Gulf Coast remain closed today, Thursday, August 27.

Currently there is no reported impact to APL Logistics operations, but we continue to closely monitor the situation.

Texas Port updates:

- The Port of Beaumont will be closed until Monday,
- the Port of Galveston remains closed through Friday
- The Port of Corpus Christi is open and operating normally

Louisiana Port Updates:

- The Port of New Orleans' cargo terminals are open and operating normally
- Port of Baton Rouge is open and operating
