Using these baseline calculations, APL Logistics then identifies ways to inject efficiency programs into existing operations for long-term emissions reductions. For remaining carbon liability, APL Logistics partners with providers of certified and verified carbon offsets, renewable fuels, and new technologies to achieve up to 100% carbon-neutral product transportation. All progress and efficiencies can be tracked, managed, and analyzed through interactive dashboards tailored to each customer.

"The importance of our sustainability platform was highlighted last week when John Kerry, U.S. Special Presidential Envoy for Climate, announced the Biden Administration is poised to issue an Executive Order requiring financial firms to consider the climate risks of their investments," said Thad Bedard, CCO at APL Logistics. "We know companies face an uphill battle to realize aggressive emissions commitments made to consumers, employees and investors; Executive Orders like this make meeting those commitments even more critical."
