

REGIONAL NETWORK UPDATE: GREATER ASIA

South Asia

- **India:** Lockdown at New Delhi has been extended through May 3, 2021 (see link [here](#)). There is no significant impact on overall operations. **CFS at New Delhi, Mumbai, and Tamil Nadu (Chennai & Tuticorin) remain open till 18:00 with limited staff.** Activities that include cargo receiving, trucking, container loading/ delivery may experience some delays.
- **Bangladesh:** The local government has decided to further extend the nationwide lockdown through May 5 to counter the surge in COVID-19 cases. There is no major impact on overall operations. Offices related to air, maritime, river, and land ports remain operational. Factories remain open on the condition that they maintain health protocols. There may be some delays in operations due to restricted public movements, labor and trucker shortages.
