REGIONAL NETWORK UPDATE: INDIA

May 25, 2021

- Lockdown has been imposed in all states through May 31, 2021 (see link <u>here</u>).
- There is some potential impact on overall CFS operations, which includes cargo receiving and stuffing due to limited labor force.
- All factories have restricted their working hours to end at 5pm daily, and there is minimal workforce available due to travel restrictions. Some factories were also voluntarily closed for the time being as a precautionary measure.
- Customs have restricted their working hours to end at 6pm daily with limited workforce.
- There is some impact on transportation to and from factories/ CFS. Drivers are not available, and only essential goods are permitted for transportation without restrictions. Vehicle E-Pass (electronic passes issued online by the state government to facilitate the commute during an emergency or urgent situation) is mandatory for every transport movement either interstate or within state.
- There are also restrictions in original carrier OBL/APLL HBL release.
