

REGIONAL NETWORK UPDATE: VIETNAM

July 28, 2021

Ho Chi Minh City

- Strict movement control has been imposed from July 26, 2021 (see link [here](#)). Due to this movement control, please expect some delays in shipments that require original documents (COO, OBL, etc) with physical stamp or printing.
- APLL has implemented appropriate COVID-19 precautionary measures in our warehouse/ flow center. All trucks to the warehouse will be disinfected and drivers are strictly to remain in the cabin. Submission of customs declaration (for certain shippers) will be done by designated CFS personnel to reduce exposure of outside parties.

Ho Chi Minh City & Hanoi

- In general, all truckers are required to show a negative Covid (PCR) certificate. Each province may have their own additional COVID-19 controls, including pre-registration or other COVID-19 tracing requirements. Consequently, long-haul South to North truck deliveries are not recommended due to such differing (provincial) implementation.

The local ports in Ho Chi Minh City and Haiphong remain operational. All APLL employees are currently working from home.
